Calling for a "Blue-Out" on Sunday, March 6th Show Your Support for Presbyterian Disaster Assistance

Between Ash Wednesday and Easter we will be collecting for the Presbyterian Church USA's "One Great Hour of Sharing" special offering. Each gift supports the *Presbyterian Hunger Program*, the *Presbyterian Committee on the Self-Development of People*, and *Presbyterian Disaster Assistance* (PDA!). While we might never experience disaster, hunger, or oppression, millions of people in our country and around the world do lack access to sustainable food sources, clean water, sanitation, education, and opportunity. The PDA website lists no less than 42 crises to which it is currently responding, both here and abroad. OGHS is the single, largest way that Presbyterians come together every year to work for a better world, and the Mission & Justice Committee has set a goal of \$5000 for our congregation.

The first Sunday in Lent every year is designated "Wear your blue t-shirt to church Sunday" as a specific testament and reference to PDA. While you might not have a blue t-shirt or think it warm enough for a t-shirt at start of March, we encourage you to don as much blue clothing as you can on March 6th to launch this year's offering and note it's importance in funding PDA across the coming year.
